


BRIEF




Born out of human history, in the future.


INSIGHTS

Design is an instinct. Design is how we answer our needs. Design is the cause for and result of human experience.




PROTOYPE


PLAN

In the weeks leading up to the final due date and Grad Ex, I will continue the editing and indexing of the content I have collected up to date, formatting the media type to the respective delivery methods.










USE EXPERIENCE






VALUE PERCEPTUAL MAP










